Treatment for pharaoh ants

On the visit, we will survey your home to find the extent and location of the problem. We will lay poison bait and may also treat the ants with a chemical which prevents the queens from laying viable eggs and reduces the size of the colony.

We will make any follow-up appointments needed to make sure the home is clear of pharaoh ants – this usually requires two further visits.
