#### **Outstanding Matters**

Planning permission

- SG: The site's extant and implemented planning permission (PA/14/02819 as amended) should be referenced within the Local Plan.
- LBTH does not consider necessary to refer to the implemented planning permission within the site allocation. Whilst the site is currently under construction, this would not be the case over the Local Plan period.

Secondary school

- SG: London Dock is not a suitable location for a school.
- LBTH: The justification for the school on the site is outlined in the Site Allocations Methodology (SED64) and in the Spatial Assessment Need for Schools (SED72).
