Eligibility

- Criteria set a minimum threshold that all authorities must meet
- Only variation is power to meet needs
- Subject only to conventional public law challenge?
- Or question of fact?

Destitution

- Power should be exercised in order to avoid breach of Article 3?
- Adult may need accommodation and subsistence, as support, solely because of destitution
- Or this need may not arise from or be related to a physical impairment, etc.
- Or accommodation and subsistence is not assistance

Ordinary residence

- New deeming provision
- Specified accommodation: care/nursing home; shared lives; supported living
- Self-funder in care home?
- Existing supported living?

Recovery of debts

- Limitation period
- Ordinary residence costs
