Early learning for two-year-olds

BC Some children may be entitled to 15 hours of free childcare in the term after their second birthday. Early learning for two year olds is only open to children that meet certain criteria such as coming from a low income family, requiring additional needs or if they are currently looked after by the council.

If you have an older child who is currently at school and getting free school meals, younger children will probably be able to get a free two year old place as well.

Tower Hamlets has some excellent nurseries, pre -school playgroups and childminders that will help children learn and play.



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
