The Early Help core training Programme is available across the Children & Families Partnership.

The training Programme:

- is accessible to all practitioners and staff who work with Tower Hamlets children, young people and their families regardless of their role, status or organisation
- promotes interagency collaboration essential to the ethos of Early Help
- promotes multi-agency participant and learning to encourage networking and to identify and support possible TAF (Team Around the Family) members
- is underpinned by whole family working and restorative practices.

The training programme is delivered by the Parental Engagement Team (PET), Parent and Family Support Service, the Behaviour and Attendance Support Service and the Children's Information Systems Team (CIS).

Early Help Practice and Assessment skills

This one day introductory course promotes whole family integrated working and will explore effective assessment, planning and review skills using the Early Help Assessment. Integrated Working for Managers

This half day training is for staff managing a team of people who work with children, young people and their families. It explores strategies for effective support and supervision, quality assurance of assessments undertaken by staff and case management.
