



Sports and games

The children played sports, mini football matches, dodgeball and group games.

Arts and crafts

In the art room, the children used their creative skills to sculpt and create models of objects such as rockets and spaceships.

Playdough

Some of the children made playdough using flour, water and salt. They enjoyed measuring the quantities and learning how playdough is made. They also shared their playdough with others at the scheme.

Trips

The children were taken on trips to local parks and to the sky gardens in Canary Wharf.

Clay making

The holiday scheme was thrilled to present a specialist clay making workshop, which was held over two days for children to participate in. The children were divided into small groups to create their own clay masterpieces. They were proud of their various 'out of this world' creations which they were able to take home.

Baking

The children did some baking, the smell of which travelled around the school. Everyone was keen to taste what they had made. Some had never baked before so enjoyed working together to mix, weigh and measure the ingredients. They learnt the process of preparing and cooking the food which they later took home.

The Felix Project donated a range of fresh fruit, bread and other food for parents and carers to take home. The food donations support our families who attend the scheme.
