On Tuesday 4 April 2023 we welcomed a visit from Ofsted who carried out an inspection of our scheme. The inspector was overwhelmed with the range of activities on offer and how happy and engaged the children were. We had a great morning showcasing our scheme and were pleased the report reflected how hard the staff work to ensure each child has an enjoyable, fun time.

The inspector felt every child was engaged in activities and staff ensured their needs were met. There were no recommendations given to us as the inspector felt we went above and beyond what other holiday provisions offer. Highlights from the report include

Easter holiday scheme

During the Easter holiday scheme, the children took part in activities from our theme 'spring is fun.' The activities the children participated in ranged from making egg-tastic collages, mini egg decorating, planting seeds, a mini sports day and finishing the scheme with an egg hunt and fancy dress party.

The children enjoyed trips to the local farm where some children saw animals for the first time. They walked to the farm in small groups and had the opportunity to pet some of the animals. They also visited some local play parks where they could use the play equipment and have fun in a different surrounding.

The children loved playing in the sun and enjoyed the outdoors. Children had the chance to learn some archery skills and by the end of the scheme were able to hold the bow, aim and hit their target. Children as always enjoyed playing the traditional hall games which encouraged them to work together as a team and make new friends. They also had access to the schools library where they could select a book and read in a cosy corner.

We welcomed Global Learning London to hold small group sessions for the children. The sessions focussed on children's wellbeing. Children had the opportunity to work in small groups to discuss their feelings through story telling.

The Felix Project continued to provide a range of fresh produce for the children to take home. Families could opt from organic bananas







and fresh carrots. Feedback from parents and carers showed how much they valued the food given.

Cooking was available daily at the scheme. The children learnt chopping, mixing and measuring skills. The children made healthy







oat cookies, homemade cheese and vegetable pizzas, fruity muffins and much more. They took pleasure in working in small groups to bake and cook the food and taste it with their friends.


