

Fast food shop in Mile End prosecuted for breach of licence

A chicken shop and take away in Mile End was prosecuted by the London Borough of Tower Hamlets for the provision of late night refreshment (selling hot food) after their licensed hours.

The case was heard on the 22nd June 2017 at Thames Magistrates' Court. The Defendants appeared represented and entered Guilty Pleas. Mohammed Fakrul ISLAM was fined the total of £780 including costs and Victim Surcharge. Zafling CHOWDHURY was fined the total of £1,430 including costs and Victim Surcharge.

Tower Hamlets Licensing Officers visited Real Taste, 212 Mile End Road and found them selling hot food past their permitted hours on Sunday 10th April 2016 despite previous warning.

Under the Licensing Act 2003, the provision of late night refreshment (selling hot food and hot drinks after 23:00 hours) without a licence is a criminal offence.
