

Restaurant in Osborn Street prosecuted for breach of licence

A restaurant in Osborn Street was prosecuted by the London Borough of Tower Hamlets for the provision of late night refreshment (selling hot food) after their licensed hours.

Mohammed ASGHAR pleaded guilty and fined the total of £1,142 including costs and Victim Surcharge. The case was heard on the 1st June 2017 at Thames Magistrates' Court.

Tower Hamlets Licensing Officers visited Shahi Karahi Restaurant on the 1st May 2016 and found them selling hot food past their permitted hours. Under the Licensing Act 2003, the provision of late night refreshment (selling hot food and hot drinks after 23:00 hours) without a licence is a criminal offence.
