**NOTICE OF A PROPOSAL TO MAKE A DOGS ON
LEAD BY DIRECTION ORDER**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of London Borough of Tower Hamlets intends to make a Dog Control Order under the above Act and the land to which it is proposed that the Order will apply is:

to all land which is open to the air and to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access (with or without payment) within the London Borough of Tower Hamlets except for land to which dogs are excluded pursuant to any Dogs Exclusion Order and those areas where dogs must be kept on leads at all times pursuant to any Dogs on Leads Order

For the purposes of the Act land which is covered is to be treated as land which is "open to the air" if it is open to the air on at least one side.

The Dog Control Order (described as a "Dogs on Lead by Direction Order") will make it an offence if a person in charge of a dog at any time on any land to which this Order applies does not comply with a direction given to him by an authorised officer of the Authority to put and keep the dog on lead unless that person has reasonable excuse or the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to his failing to do so. The maximum penalty on conviction will be a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£1,000 as at 24th January 2014).
