Westferry Printworks site allocation (4.12)	Remove the leisure centre from the site boundary	For clarification to reflect the planning application on this site
Wood Wharf site allocation (4.13)	Amend boundary to more closely reflect the planning application, particularly in relation to the southern boundary	Amend boundary to more closely reflect the planning application, particularly in relation to the southern boundary
Policies Map & figure 6	Amend boundary of the "Skyline of Strategic Importance" to reflect the Canary Wharf tall building zone	For clarity and consistency with policy D.DH6
