

ADOPTION STATEMENT THE LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS

FISH ISLAND AREA ACTION PLAN (FI AAP) – DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT (DPD)

Purpose

In accordance with Regulation 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Tower Hamlets adopted the Fish Island Area Action Plan (FI AAP) on **19th September 2012**.

The FI AAP was subject to an Examination in Public (EiP) from Wednesday July 18 to Wednesday 25 July 2012, by an independent Planning Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The FI AAP was found 'sound' subject to modifications which have been incorporated into the Adopted FI APP.

Any person aggrieved by the decision to adopt the FI AAP may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 on the grounds that:

- the document is not within the appropriate power;
- a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

The application must be made promptly and in any event no later than the end of the period of six weeks from the date of the FI AAPs adoption, which is **31st October 2012**.

Subject Matter of the FI AAP

The FI AAP will ensure the vision and strategic principles set out in the Local Development Framework (LDF) Core Strategy for Fish Island are delivered, including the provision of the necessary supporting infrastructure to facilitate regeneration. The FI APP will be used as a Development Plan Document (DPD) to determine planning applications within the defined boundary and will provide certainty and guidance to investors, developers and the community.

From 1 October 2012, the London Legacy Development Cooperation (LLDC) will adopt the FI AAP as part of its Local Plan and it will be used to determine planning applications until the LLDC prepares its own Local Plan for the area.
