This statement provides the Council’s response to the issues stated within the Lee Valley Regional Park Authority’s Position Statement for the Fish Island AAP Examination in Public. It does not seek to repeat information relating to the Council’s position as stated elsewhere.

1. Issue 1

In relation to Issue 4 and the Hackney Wick Hub, the Authority wishes to make a further point to support its original representation concerning Policy FI 5.1.

The Authority seeks the following amendment to Policy FI 5.1 ‘Delivering a vibrant hub at Hackney Wick’ point 6: (change in bold text)

*“6. **New developments to be well integrated into the Hub and its surroundings, enhancing routes to, from and within the Hub to the wider Fish Island Hackney Wick area and to the Lee Valley Regional Park and future Queen Elizabeth Park.**”*

Amend policy to provide reference to the Lee Valley Regional Park.
