

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – BLOSSOM STREET & FLEUR DE LIS STREET E1

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, having consulted City of London, made an Order, which will prohibit pedestrian and vehicular traffic from entering, stopping or proceeding in:

- a) Blossom Street for a distance of approximately 50 metres, south, from its junction with Fleur De Lis Street;
- b) Fleur De Lis Street between its junction with Elder Street and its junction with Blossom Street;
- c) Fleur De Lis Passage between its junction with Blossom Street and its junction with Norton Folgate

The restriction on vehicular traffic will enable the construction works to be carried on the public highway adjacent to the property by British Land Property Management on behalf of M3 Consulting.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Folgate Street, Commercial Street and Fleur De Lis Street and vice versa or Commercial Street, Shoreditch High Street and Norton Folgate.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will operate from Monday 25th February 2019 to Sunday 24th July 2022 and at times when temporary traffic signs are placed on the public highway pursuant to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
