**TEMPORARY BANNED TURN, PROHIBITION OF STOPPING & TRAFFIC –
GREENFIELD ROAD & COKE STREET E1**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets made a notice, which will prohibit or ban:

- a) Pedestrian and vehicular traffic from stopping at the eastern kerb line of Greenfield Road, approximately 3 metres wide, for a distance of approximately 40 metres, north, from its junction with Commercial Road;
- b) Vehicular traffic from proceeding in Coke Street between its junction with Plumbers Row and its junction with Greenfield Road;
- c) Vehicular traffic from turning left into Coke Street from its junction with Plumbers Row.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will enable works to be carried out in the above section of the public highway by Regal Homes Construction Limited.

The alternative routes for vehicular traffic will be via Plumbers Row, Coke Street (westbound), Adler Street, Commercial Road and Greenfield Road.

Throughout the duration of the works, the existing two-way working in Coke Street between its junction with Greenfield Road and its junction with Plumbers Row will be made one way westbound in an east to west direction.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will operate from Monday 19th August 2019 to Wednesday 19th August 2020 and at times when traffic signs are placed on the public highway pursuant to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Direction 2016.
