

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **THE LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)**

### **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – DAVENANT STREET E1**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, having consulted with Transport for London, made an Order, which will prohibit vehicular traffic from entering, stopping or proceeding in Davenant Street between its junction with Old Montague Street and its junction with Whitechapel Road.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will enable new water connection and reinstating works to be carried out on the public highway by Agility Alliance on behalf of Thames Water.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Old Montague Street, Vallance Road and Whitechapel Road.

Throughout the duration of the works, and at times when the “one way” and “no entry” traffic signs are covered, the existing one way working in Davenant Street between its junction with Old Montague Street and its junction with Whitechapel Road will be temporarily suspended.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will operate from Monday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2019 to Friday 16<sup>th</sup> August 2019 and at times when temporary traffic signs are placed on the public highway pursuant to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
