THE LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – MONIER ROAD E3

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets made an Order, which will prohibit vehicular traffic from entering, stopping or proceeding into the length of carriageway outside 217 Monier Road for a distance of approximately 50 metres, south-west, from its junction with Roach Road.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will enable electrical works to be carried out on the public highway by UK Power Networks.

The alternative routes for vehicular will be via Roach Road, Wyke Road, Smeed Road, and Monier Road and vice versa or Roach Road, Beachy Road, Smeed Road and Monier Road.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will operate from Monday 2nd September 2019 to Wednesday 4th September 2019 and at times when temporary traffic signs are placed on the public highway pursuant to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
