

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC & BANNED TURN – OLD MONTAGUE STREET E1

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, having consulted with Transport for London, made an Order, which will prohibit or ban vehicular traffic from:

- a) Entering, stopping or proceeding in the length of carriageway in Old Montague Street for a distance of approximately 40 metres, east, from its junction with Wentworth Street;
- b) Turning right into Old Montague Street from its junction with Osborn Street.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will enable accessing a manhole to existing BT underground ducting route to be carried out on the public highway by Hire-A-Lite on behalf of BT Openreach.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Brick Lane, Chicksand Street, Casson Street and Old Montague Street.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will operate from Monday 2nd September 2019 to Saturday 7th September 2019 and at times when temporary traffic signs are placed on the public highway pursuant to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
