

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – QUAKER STREET E1

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, made an Order, which will prohibit vehicular traffic from entering, stopping, loading, unloading or proceeding in the length of carriageway outside 1 – 9 Quaker Street for a distance of approximately 70 metres, between its junction with Grey Eagle Street and its junction with Wheler Street.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will enable or allow works to be carried out adjacent to the public highway by Gilbert Ash Limited.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Grey Eagle Street, Corbet Place, Jerome Street, Commercial Street and Quaker Street or Brick Lane, Bethnal Green Road, Commercial Street and Quaker Street for HGVs.

Throughout the durations of the works, and at times when the “one way” and “no entry” traffic signs are covered, the existing one way working in Quaker Street between its junction with Grey Eagle Street and its junction with Wheler Street will be temporarily suspended.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will operate on Monday 7th August 2017 to Tuesday 15th October 2019 when temporary traffic signs are placed on the public highway pursuant to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
