

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **THE LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 (1)**

### **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC – REPTON STREET E14**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, made an Order, which will prohibit vehicular traffic and the southern side of pedestrian traffic from entering, stopping or proceeding in Repton Street from a point approximately 30 metres east of Carr Street to a point approximately 30 metres to the easternmost end from its junction with Carr Street.

The restriction on vehicular traffic will enable re-cladding works to be carried out in the public highway by Hill Partnerships. Pedestrian access to residential properties will be maintained at the northern side or northern footway.

There are no alternative routes for vehicular traffic as it is a dead end street.

The Order will operate from Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2019 for a period of six months and at times when temporary traffic signs and cones are placed on the public highway pursuant to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
