The Tower Hamlets (Prescribed Route) (No.1) Traffic Order 2019

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2019 made the above mentioned Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of, and part 1 of schedule 5, of the Local Government Act 1985 and in accordance with regulation 23 of the Local Authorities Traffic Order (procedure) (England and Wales) Regulation 1996, so as to continue in force indefinitely the provisions of The Tower Hamlets (Prescribed Route) (No.1) Experimental Traffic Order 2017.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to on a permanent basis, prohibit any vehicles, from entering or proceeding in the length of carriageway in Chester Street which lies:
  - a) Between its junction with the eastern kerb line of Menotti Street and a point approximately 3.5 metres east of that kerb line;
  - b) At its junction with Vallance Road.
3. A copy of the Traffic Order which will come into operation on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2019 can be inspected, by prior appointment, at the offices of Place, Network Management Team, First Floor, Room 1.7, John Onslow House, 1 Ewart Place, London E3 5EQ during office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the expiration of a period of six weeks from the date on which the Order was made.
4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision provided therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks of the date on which the Order were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
