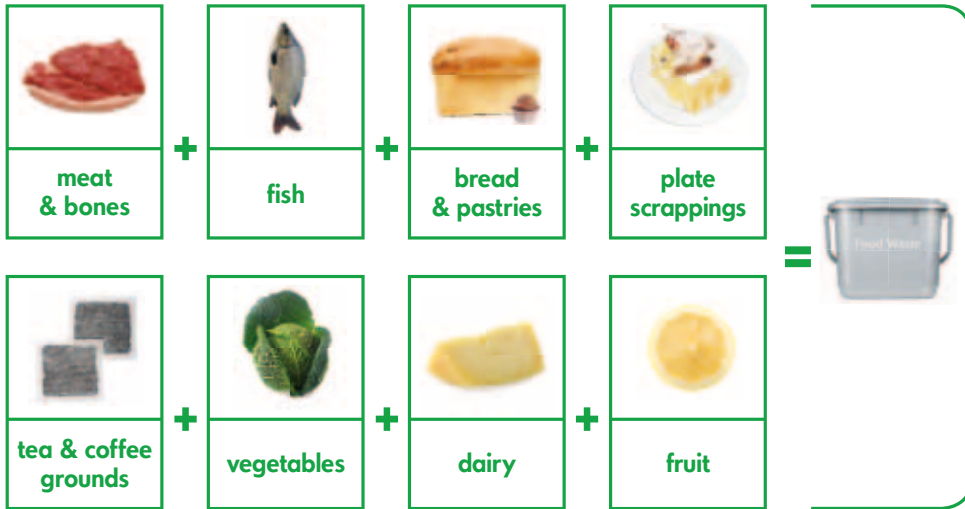


Food waste

What can I put in my caddy?

You can put any raw or cooked food into your caddy.

By recycling your food waste you will reduce the amount of food in landfill sites. Rotting food in landfill produces methane which contributes to climate change and, as the cost of sending food waste to landfill is increasing, you will help the Council and its residents save money too.

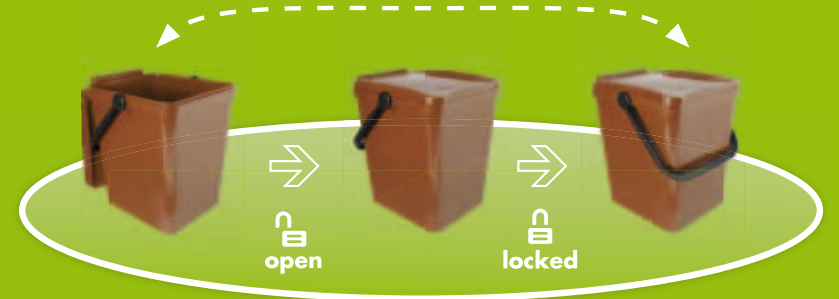


How do I use the service?

1 Line your caddy with the corn starch liners provided, fill it with food waste.



2 When it's full tie the corn starch liner and put it in your bigger outside food bin.



3 To help stop pests lock the outside bin by moving the handle forward.

What happens to my food waste?

Your food waste is taken with your garden waste to a special processing plant where it is recycled into compost which is used on farms and community gardens.

- !** Only use the corn starch liners provided never use plastic bags as these do not compost.
